

Travel Information:

Visa, Currency, Transportation, Internet access

For the visa, please refer to the HKSAR Immigration website for details: <http://www.immd.gov.hk/eng/services/visas/visit-transit/visit-visa-entry-permit.html#part1>. Based on the table in the website, for those guests from US, Spain, UK, Colombia and Rumania, they can enter Hong Kong as a tourist within the stated period without a visa. But for Taiwan, application is required. Let us know if there is any specific concerns, we can check with the HK Immigration office in advance.

The currency used in Hong Kong is the Hong Kong dollar, HKD. There are ATM machines at the airport, and currency exchange posts.

For transportation between the airport and your hotel you could use a taxi. Do not expect taxi drivers accepting cards, you will need to have cash. Another means is the airport express train. The express train cost one way from the airport to Central Station HKD110.

If you are planning on using the public transportation, just buy the Octopus card for the MTR system (HKD200). You can buy it right at the airport. At the airport, make sure you have enough money in the card to pay for the airport express train (one way HKD110).

As Internet is concerned, many coffee shops, restaurants have Wi-Fi that you could use with your cellphones.
